For Your Child’s Safety

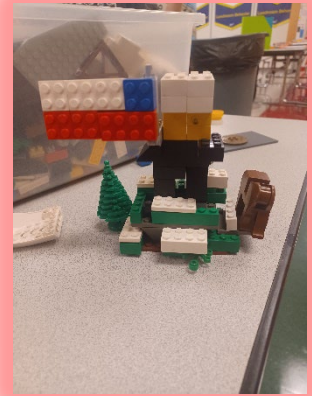

Build A Thon

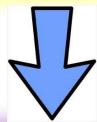
