Dear Parents,

Welcome to Lincoln Elementary Mt. Lebanon Extended Day Program. We look forward to providing a fun, enriching and supportive environment for your child. Our after-school program will offer active play, opportunities for socialization, STEAM and creative social/emotional engaging activities.

Drop off: Parents may park along Ralston Place in the GO ZONE to drop off from 7:00am to 8:15am. After that time you will NOT be allowed to park in the GO ZONE for drop off. When dropping off your child please turn on your hazards and walk them to **Door C15.**

Pick up: Parents may park along Ralston Place in the GO ZONE to pick up from 3:45pm to 6:30pm. Please put on hazard lights and escort students from the extended day entrance at Door C15.

Extended Day Kindergarten Drop off and pick up: You may use the lower parking lot off Beverly Road, pull into a parking space (If possible). Please turn on hazard lights. Adults must escort student(s) to and from the entrance at door **C6**.

Snacks: MLEDP will provide a simple packaged afternoon snack. Attention is given to select healthy portions the children enjoy to hold them over to suppertime. **Note: Kindergarten Care students leaving at 3:30 will not receive a PM snack.**

Programming: A variety of active play, science, nature, art and imaginary play activities will be planned for both indoor and outdoor spaces. Respect is a vital part of how we relate to one another at MLEDP. We show this in our regard for other's property, belongings, beliefs, and physical and emotional well-being. We

are anticipating a year filled with growth, friendships, discoveries, and enjoyment for all.

Health and Safety Plan: We will follow procedures in the Health and Safety Plan at mledp.org to keep everyone safe. Please review the expectations with your child to help prepare them for MLEDP.
